Portfolio Changes

As described in the February 17 Repositioning Alert, positions in Hennessy Focus 30 (HFTFX) and Royce Value (RYVFX) were eliminated and the position in Heartland Value Plus (HRVIX) was reduced. These sales resulted in total proceeds of \$11,557.18 on February 17. The above proceeds were equally split for purchasing shares in Parnassus Equity Income (PRBLX) and Yacktman (YACKX) on February 18.
